I sincerely hope you had a happy and safe holiday season, and I look forward to serving as your voice in the state House of Representatives.

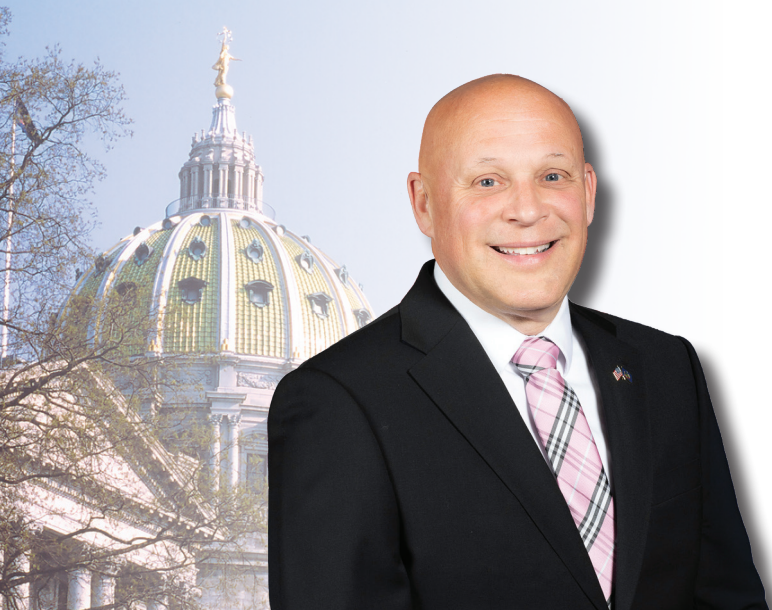

OPEN HOUSE

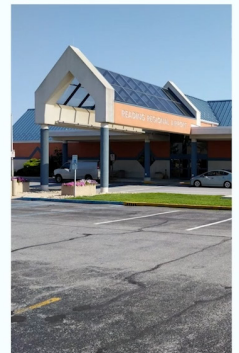
On Thursday, Jan. 9, my staff and I hosted our first Open House which was well attended.
